

## ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE IN FUNERAL SERVICE

This Associate of Arts Degree program is offered in the traditional on-campus classroom setting. The Associate of Arts Degree in Funeral Service (Funeral Directing and Embalming) is a 62-semester hour program and takes 12-16 months to complete. The estimated cost for the program is \$24,640. (Also, most states require an apprenticeship.)
